#### 5.4.10 Admission to courses within study programmes

There is a possibility to be admitted to a specific course of a study programme if there is availability and that the entry requirements are fulfilled, despite the course not being advertised in the course catalogue. Applying for courses within study programmes must be made no later than 15 April for the autumn term and 15 October for the spring term. Applications that arrive after these given dates will be dealt with in turn and if any places are available. In the case of more applicants than places, a selection will be made. The student's grades and the result from the Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test will be taken into consideration in this selection.
