

Statement of Cost

From the web site of the Migration Board:

The support requirement is at present a minimum of **SEK 8,190 per month**.

You must show that you have secured maintenance for the period for which you are applying for a residence permit. This means that you must show that you have money available in your own bank assets, grant or similar, for example a study grant from your home country.

If you are going to study for one year or longer, you must show that your maintenance is secured for ten months of the year. See example in the fact box below.

You must enclose a bank statement showing that you have your **own bank assets** available in an account belonging to you and from which only you and your husband or wife, if you have one, can **withdraw money**. The Migration Board do not accept that you share an account with, for example, your parents or a relative. Nor do they accept that a sponsor (such as a relative or a company) covers your support while you are in Sweden, unless the funds are lodged in your own account. Credit, funds or shares are not counted as your own bank assets.
