
Högskolan i Halmstad, Halmstad University College, is a recognized state run higher education institution in Sweden. Högskolan i Halmstad has the right to award first and second level degrees. The degrees awarded by högskolan i Halmstad are equal to and provide the same academic rights as degrees awarded by other recognized universities and university colleges in Sweden.

The universities and other institutions of higher education for which the State has responsibility are listed in the Appendix 1 to the Higher Education Ordinance (1999:100), www.sweden.gov.se.

Swedish higher education institutions have autonomy in the organization of studies, use of resources and internal organization. All educational activities are funded by the State.

Högskoleverket, The Swedish National Agency for Higher Education, is a central agency responsible for matters related to institutions of higher education. The agency evaluates, exercises supervision and reviews the operations of the higher education institutions.
