

Exercise 6: Oral presentation as part of the examination

You should present a paper / article which deals with sensor fusion, preferably applied to mobile systems. Preferably it should deal with existing products and systems, although research related papers are also allowed.

It is important to choose such papers which are close to implementation (i.e. not on an abstract level). A good guideline is that you should be able to reproduce the work based on the paper.

You should do the following:

- 1) Formulate at least 5 questions for discussion in class (similar to the papers and questions previously in the course)
- 2) Hand out the paper / article and questions two days in advance.
- 3) Present the paper on transparencies or by using powerpoint. Duration 15 minutes.
- 4) Discuss the paper based on the questions and be prepared to answer questions about the paper / article from the class and from the teacher / teachers. Duration 15 minutes.

You should also do the following to pass this part of the examination.

- 1) Be present and participate actively in the discussion of the papers presented by your fellow-students.
- 2) Read the papers and the questions of your fellow students in advance.
