Examiner's comment

There were quite spread reviews of the teachers' work and effort- it is quite difficult to know what it is the students would have liked to have seen improved- but we will obviously think about what we could have done differently. We had changed the examination for this course somewhat since last time the course was given- with 2 group works instead of one- and I thought it worked well. I feel it is good to spread out the different examinations over the course rather than to have a large exam at the end. We will think about how the examination might be improved even more for next time the course is given.
