Examiner's comment

The teacher of the course was happy with the feed back he has got for the course and generally students seem very happy with the course as well. However- he did have some critical comments/advice:

"

1. Language skills, particularly among non-Swedish students , need to improve otherwise they cannot understand the lectures and readings. The screening of students before admission might need to be tightened and/or students should be required to take intensive language courses while in Sweden (they could come a month earlier than the term and use that time to improve the language)

2. Motivation-in the beginning of the PROGRAM (not only each course), it should be impressed on students that they actually have to read the course material. Also that they have to attend the classes and not to stay at home (maybe a 90% compulsory attendance can be written into the program description). If this message is re-inforced with each course they take, they will get the message and be serious about their studies and understand that they cannot get away with little effort."

As examinator of this course I would like to add that we have- again and again- reminded the students of the importance of attending lectures and actually reading the course literature but not all of them seem to take this to heart. So perhaps it is important to remind them of this again.
