Examiner's comment

My impressions are mixed. On the positive side: seminar attendance and students' presentations including written summaries were satisfactory, in some cases very good. The few (11 out of 22) take-home exams that have been submitted were relatively satisfactory (3 passed with distinction, 6 passed, 2 not passed). Instructions have been followed with good results in most cases. On the negative side: low lecture attendance or late arrival, late submission of papers. Also, in some cases the language capabilities of foreign students are insufficient.
