

# Statement of Cost

# From the website of the Migration Board:

The support requirement is at present a minimum of SEK 10 314 per month.

You must show that you have secured maintenance for the period for which you are applying for a residence permit.

You must enclose a bank statement showing that you have your **own bank assets** available on an account belonging to you and from which only you and your husband or wife, if you have one, can withdraw money. The Migration Agency do not accept that you share an account with, for example, your parents or a relative. Nor do they accept that a sponsor (such as a relative or a company) covers your support while you are in Sweden, unless the funds are lodged in your own account. Credit, funds or shares are not counted as your own bank assets.

You must show that you have secured maintenance for the period for which you are applying for a residence permit.
